

THE GIFT OF SINFREENESS

MAN IN SIN IS VOID OF GOD

- 1. Sin in the heart is idol values in the heart or No God in the heart. Eze.14: 2-5; Psa.10: 4.
- 2. The man in sin is also said to have the Carnal mind; he cannot please God, he has no peace. He may do good works for a pretense but not from faith. Hence, he truly cannot keep God's Commandments. Rom.8: 6-8; Isa.57: 20,21; Matt.23:14; Rom.9:31,32.
- 3. Sinful man is also called 'Ungodly, wicked, children of the Devil, worm, unjust, good for nothing, brute beast. Jude 1: 15; 2 Pet.2: 7; 1 John 3: 10; Job 25: 6; 1 Pet. 3: 18; Jer.13: 10; 2 Pet. 2: 12; Jude 1: 10.




4. This is as a result of the absence of God. There is no God in the heart of sinful man. Ephesians 2:12; Romans 1:27-30; Ephesians 4:17-19.

The solution to this sinful, depraved experience of man is God in the heart through imputation, making the man sinfree. This is what the Plan of Salvation is all about, the gift of God for sinfreeness in the experience. This is explained on the next page.

SINFREENESS IS GIVEN TO MAN BY YHWH GOD

- 1. Sinfreeness is a gift from God, it is called Justification by faith or forgiveness of sins. Rom 4:2,6,7; Rom .3: 28; Acts 26: 18.
- 2. The man must repent and believe the Gospel in order to get forgiveness or be made sinfree. Mark 1: 15; Acts 13: 38; Rom.1: 16; Rom 6:6,7,18,22.
- 3. Sinfreeness is also called 'The new birth, Regeneration, The cleansing, The gift of life, Justification, The washing, Putting on of the new man, Forgiveness of sins, Sanctification, Conversion and Made Righteous. 1 John 3:9, Tit.3: 5; John 15:3; Rom.6: 23; Acts 13:39; Isa.1:16; Col.3: 10; 1 Cor.6:9-11; Acts 3: 19; Rom.5:19.



- 4. The man also is given the gift of the Holy Spirit in his heart at Conversion, which worketh in him to bring forth good works or fruits of righteousness Gal. 3:7-9,14; Gal. 4:6; Eph.1: 13; Gal.5: 19-25.
- 5. The Holy Spirit is God Himself who is our Righteousness that dwells in the heart by faith; working in us to do that which is well pleasing in His sight. (John 4:24; 2 Cor 3;17); Jere.23:5,6; Heb.13: 20,21; Phil 2:13
- 6. Being made sinfree or free from sin, he has peace with God and is now able to obey all God's Commandments, because God who is Righteousness dwells in the heart/mind. Rom 5:1; Rom.8:6; Heb.13:20,21; James 2:8-12; Isa.56: 2; Rom.3: 21,22,31-32
- 7. God dwelling in the heart means that there are no idols or sin in the heart; he or she is now a son or daughter of God. 2 Cor.6:16-18; Gal.4: 6.

Dear reader, if you have studied this tract from beginning to this point and you feel sorry or guilty for your sins, then it is because God has convicted you. "Godly sorrow worketh repentance" 2Cor.7:10. So your next step is to repent of your sins and let God justify and make you sinfree. "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9
